

We charge a basic rental fee of \$50.00 for 1 to 4 hours – this includes, tables, chairs, dishes and access to the activity area kitchen with fridge, stove, microwave. (An additional fee may be added should you wish to reserve the area for an extended period of time)

A \$20.00 fee is requested if you would like the Chalet to supply Coffee, Tea, Cream and Sugar for your event.

A \$50.00 refundable security deposit is requested if you would like access to the shuffle board and pool table.

Fundraising for what? What are we working on?

- New wheelchair washroom: We are currently obtaining quotes to develop a new wheelchair/family washroom in the front dining area. Although the current washrooms are large – they are not fully wheel-chair accessible. We hope to have this new washroom completed by the New Year.
- Automatic Doors: As many are aware, there is still much work to be done with the automatic doors. Having one automatic door on many of the 2-door entrances is somewhat redundant and we are working hard to raise more funds for the additional doors. We are also looking for a reputable company to complete this project a company who will also provide timely service repairs when required. Delays with repair parts is still an issue with the first set of doors that were installed last summer (we are hoping to eliminate much of the same further frustration)
- Front-entrance solution: The Chalet is also obtaining quotes and ideas on how to properly resolve the chilly front entrance issue (North wind coming into the dining hall). This has been a very long on-going issue and management would like a guaranteed solution, and therefore, we are taking time to review each idea and quote very carefully to ensure our funds are well-spent for an actual solution (and not just a temporary band-aid solution).
- Sidewalk fix: The sidewalk in front of our building is beginning to crumble in places and is definitely needing a fix. We are obtaining quotes on this.

Changes in Rent:

Please be advised that the Chalet Malouin's Tenant fiscal year (for rent purposes) has changed from renewing on November 1st to now renewing on January 1st. These new dates will now align with the provincial Rental Tenancies Branch.

Effective January 1st, 2024:

- Please be advised any rent discounts previously provided from MB Housing will no longer be offered
 - Any rent increases will be effective January 1st, 2024.

Letters will be going to all residents the first week of October regarding any changes in January rent.

Please note that 'Rent Assist' can be re-applied for to compensate for any eliminations of the MB Housing discount and/or increases in rent. Please stop in to the Services to Seniors office (located in the Chalet) and speak with Sherisse Harder, or stop in to our Admin Office to speak with the Chalet Malouin Manager -Sheryl St. Hilaire to discuss further. Reminder Note: MB Housing Discount amount is NOT the same as MB Subsidy amount.
